**2:30pm - 5:00pm** Before arriving at your hotel of choice visit **1 WILDLIFE SAFARI**, a drive through the 600-acre park where the animals roam free. Have a close encounter with a cheetah, lion, bear, giraffe or elephant among others. [www.wildlifesafari.net](http://www.wildlifesafari.net)

**WILD & SCENIC NORTH UMPQUA** (Full Day Tour)

**2** National Scenic Byway, Highway 138 [www.fs.fed.us/r6/umpqua](http://www.fs.fed.us/r6/umpqua)

**3** Colliding Rivers Viewpoint (mile post 16.4)

**4** Waterfalls on the North Umpqua River [www.blm.gov/or/districts/roseburg/recreation/Thundering\\_Waters/](http://www.blm.gov/or/districts/roseburg/recreation/Thundering_Waters/) Along the way, hike into several of the waterfalls. **Susan Creek Falls** (milepost 28) and **Fall Creek Falls** (milepost 32) are a couple of short hikes.

**12:00pm lunch at 5 Steamboat Inn** Enjoy lunch at the historic Steamboat Inn - milepost 38, then visit **Tokenee Falls** (milepost 59) and **Watson Falls** (milepost 61)

**6** Diamond Lake, **7** Mt. Thielsen, and **8** Crater Lake Enjoy Diamond Lake and check out the view of Mt. Thielsen the lightning rod of the Cascades (milepost 78). Take in the beauty of world-famous Crater Lake - North entrance. (milepost 86). Head back into Roseburg.

### DAY THREE

**HISTORIC CITIES Historic Roseburg** (Full Day Tour)

Experience the history of **9 Roseburg Town Center** which offers an assortment of shops, art galleries, antique stores and restaurants. Professional, creative depictions of historical figures and events representing the Umpqua Valley at the **10 Douglas County Museum**. Thousands of square feet of exhibit galleries, storage areas, library, photo laboratory, auditorium, gift shop and research facilities. View the galleries and visit the gift shop of the **11 Umpqua Valley Arts Center**, located in the original 1917 Veterans Administration building on Harvard Avenue. [www.uvarts.com](http://www.uvarts.com)

Just 12 miles north of Roseburg on Interstate 5 is Oakland. Established in 1881 around a grist mill, is **12 Oakland**. Explore historic brick buildings, a museum, antique shops, and a restaurant with old-fashioned ice cream parlor and fine dining. Heading north on I-5 exit # 142 will tour you through the rolling landscape of lush green pastures and onto **13 MarshAnne Landing** for some wine tasting and art viewing.
