DAY ONE

2:30pm - 5:00pm Before arriving at your hotel of choice visit **1 WILDLIFE SAFARI**, a drive through the 600-acre park where the animals roam free. Have a close encounter with a cheetah, lion bear, giraffe or elephant among others. If time permits visit one of the wineries on the south & central wine tour. www.visitroseburg.com/wineriesmap.php
5:30pm Check into your hotel of choice. See list of recommended FIT and Group Tour hotels on reserve side.
7:30pm DINNER of your choice at a recommended restaurant.

DAY TWO

WILD & SCENIC NORTH UMPQUA (full day tour)
2 National Scenic Byway, Highway 138 www.fs.fed.us/r6/umpqua
3 Colliding Rivers Viewpoint (mile post 16.4)
4 Waterfalls on the North Umpqua River www.co.douglas.or.us/parks/brochures/north_umpqua_river.pdf
Along the way, hike into several of the waterfalls. **Susan Creek Falls** (milepost 28) and **Fall Creek Falls** (milepost 32) are a couple of short hikes.
12:00pm lunch at 5 Steamboat Inn Enjoy lunch at the historic Steamboat Inn (milepost 61)
6 Diamond Lake, 7 Mt. Thielsen, and 8 Crater Lake
Enjoy Diamond Lake and check out the view of Mt. Thielsen the lightning rod of the Cascades (milepost 78). Take in the beauty of world-famous Crater Lake - North Entrance. (milepost 86). Head back to Roseburg. **DINNER** at a recommended restaurant.

DAY THREE

HISTORIC CITIES Historic Roseburg (full day tour)
Experience the history of **9 Roseburg Downtown** which offers an assortment of shops, art galleries, restaurants and brew pubs. Professional, creative depictions of historical figures and events representing the Land of Umpqua are at the **10 Douglas County Museum**. Thousands of square feet of exhibit galleries, storage areas, library, photo laboratory, auditorium, gift shop and research facilities. www.umpquavalley museums.org
View the galleries and visit the gift shop of the **11 Umpqua Valley Arts Center**, located in the original 1917 Veterans Administrative building part of Roseburg's Historic Register District. Just 12 miles north of Roseburg on Interstate 5 is Oakland. Established in 1881 around a grist mill, is **12 Oakland**. Explore historic brick buildings, a museum, antique shops, and a restaurant with old fashioned ice cream parlor and fine dining. Heading north on I-5 exit #142 will tour you through the rolling landscape of lush green pastures and onto the wineries of the **13 north wine tour** of the Land of Umpqua. www.visitroseburg.com/wineriesmap.php
